



#### **Chester Eastside Ministries**

Media Presbyterian Church looks forward to renewing our long-time partnership with CEM.

#### Frederick Douglass Christian School

Hundreds of children throughout the economically-distressed community of Chester have found a safe, nurturing environment to learn, to grow and to be challenged at Frederick-Douglass Christian School (FDCS). Its curriculum stresses both the academic and spiritual development of students and meets all Pennsylvania state requirements. MPC members have volunteered in all aspects of the school since 1995.

In addition to these special Mission/ Ministry opportunities, your contribution to Lenten Loaves of Love enables us to provide tulips and daffodils to make our sanctuary beautiful for Easter and to send cheer to our shut-ins after the service.
