The Giving Tree by Shel Silverstein

The Shack by William P. Young

Mere Christianity C.S. Lewis

In the classic *Mere Christianity*, C.S. Lewis, the most important writer of the 20th century, explores the common ground upon which all of those of Christian faith stand together. Bringing together Lewis' legendary broadcast talks during World War Two from his three previous books *The Case for Christianity*, *Christian Behavior*, and *Beyond Personality*, *Mere Christianity* provides an unequaled opportunity for believers and nonbelievers alike to hear this powerful apologetic for the Christian faith.

The Great Divorce by C. S. Lewis

C.S. Lewis' *The Great Divorce* is a classic Christian allegorical tale about a bus ride from hell to heaven. An extraordinary meditation upon good and evil, grace and judgment, Lewis's revolutionary idea in the *The Great Divorce* is that the gates of Hell are locked from the inside. Using his extraordinary descriptive powers, Lewis' *The Great Divorce* will change the way we think about good and evil.

"The Spirit-Filled Life", by Charles Stanley

The book points out that many Christians ignore the Holy Spirit, either because they simply don't understand the concept or because the Spirit doesn't seem as "real" or

tangible as Jesus. In doing so, believers miss out on an important gift and resource in our daily lives. The book explains the Holy Spirit, how the Holy Spirit is an essential part of our faith, and how to draw closer to the Holy Spirit.

This book also fits well with our new sermon series on the Acts of the Apostles.

Celebration of Discipline, Prayer - Richard J.Foster

Both books are practical basic serious Christianity. Moderate read

<u>If You Want To Walk On Water You've Got To Get Out Of The Boat</u> - John Ortberg Uplifting, Challenging, Inspiring and supportive. Easy read

As the name implies, the book makes the point that it's not enough to be aware of Jesus or "have faith" - a Christian needs to take steps to act on that faith. The book discusses facing our fears, stretching ourselves as Christians, and making our faith an integral part of our everyday lives.

The book is a fairly light read -- not too deep. Suitable for youth as well as adults.
